**ORDER:-**

In the letter first read above, the Member Secretary, State Planning Commission, has conveyed its recommendation for supply of Pneumatic Handloom to Handloom Weavers at a cost of Rs.45 lakh per year for next 3 years, as an Innovative initiative on 60:40 basis to be shared between State Government and Handloom Co-operative Societies. Accordingly, the State's commitment is restricted to Rs.135.00 lakh for the period of three years.

2. The Director of Handlooms and Textiles in her letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above has stated among others that they have proposed to provide "Pneumatic Handloom" to Handloom weavers, so as to reduce the strain in wearing and also to improve their productivity, thereby getting higher earnings. The tentative cost for purchase of one "Pneumatic Handloom" is estimated to Rs.75,000/-. The cost will be borne by State Government and Beneficiary/Society Contribution in the Ratio of 60:40. It is proposed to provide 100 "Pneumatic Handlooms" per year totally to 300 pneumatic handlooms over a period of 3 years, for which, financial assistance of Rs.2,25,00,000/- is required. The State Government Contribution for 3 years is Rs.1.35 Crore and Society Contribution for 3 years will be Rs.90.00 Lakh.

3. The Director of Handlooms and Textiles has therefore requested the Government to issue necessary orders to approve the project of supply of 100 "pneumatic Handlooms" per year totally to 300 pneumatic Handlooms at a total cost of Rs.2.25 crore under State Innovation Fund for 3 years and requested to sanction a sum of Rs.45,00,000/- in first phase under "State Innovation Fund" towards State Government contribution for supply of 100 Pneumatic Handloom for Handloom Weavers for the year 2015-2016.

4. The Government, after careful consideration, accept the proposal of the Director of Handlooms and Textiles and accordingly the project for supply of "Pneumatic Handlooms" for supply to 300 Handloom weavers at a total cost of Rs.2.25 Crore has been approved under "State Innovation Fund" as detailed below:-

5. As per the approval of project set out at para 4 above, sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.45,00,000/- (Rupees Forty five lakhs only) Under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives Scheme [Part-II schemes] for the supply of 100 "Pneumatic Handloom" for Handloom weavers for the year 2015 -2016.

6. The amount sanctioned in para 5 above shall be met from the State Innovation fund and debited to the following head of account:-

"2851 - 00. Village and Small Industries - 103. Handloom Industries - Scheme in the Twelfth Five Year Plan - II. State Plan - LA. Supply of Pneumatic Handloom for Handloom Weavers - Scheme under State Innovation Fund - 09.Grants-in-Aid-03. Grants for Specific Schemes"

The above expenditure shall be adjusted by deducting under the following head of account:

7. The Director of Handlooms and Textiles is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 5 above. She is also requested to ensure that after collecting the beneficiaries societies share, the State share amount has to be released. The Director of Handlooms and Textiles is also directed that the pneumatic Handloom has to be supplied to the needy eligible beneficiary of the Handloom co-operative society on proportionate basis.

8. The Director of Handlooms and Textiles is requested to send an action taken report to the Government, periodically.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance (Industries) Department vide its U.O. No.30760/Ind/2015 dated 03.06.2015.

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
