**Order :**

The Project Director, Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA), Chennai, has submitted the proposal viz., "Tamil Nadu Excels" under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) under State Innovation Fund for the year 2015-2016. Accordingly, the Project Director, RMSA has submitted the following details :-

"Secondary and Higher Secondary Education in Tamil Nadu plays a vital role in the academic ladder of a student. TANEX is designed to equip and enrich him/her during this significant period. In addition to his academic performance, his knowledge is tested through various talent search exams at the State and National level. As a first step towards student empowerment, TANEX aspires to enrich and equip select students studying in Government schools to perform exceedingly well in their State Board examinations conducted at different levels."

2) Based on the performance in 2014-15 Board Examinations the following five Districts were selected for active concentration:-

3) The Project Director, RMSA, has further stated that various strategies and interventions are planned to boost the performance of the students in these Districts. To achieve this target, subject expert teams are to be constituted in each Educational District from a league of proficient and efficient teachers. Formulation and implementation of the project will be guided and monitored by the respective District Educational Officers. Coaching classes under TANEX are to be carried out at two levels - Secondary and Higher Secondary at Educational District level as designed below:-

- Eligible students are to be identified.
- Formation of subject experts' team.
- Preparation of quality courseware.
- Distribution of the printed material to the select students free of cost.
- Scheduling weekend, term holidays and summer vacation classes.
- Conducting unit tests and mock tests.
- Evaluation of the tests and further motivation.
- Monitoring the implementation and development of the project.

4) The State Planning Commission after detailed discussions and decided to accept the above scheme and implement it as a Pilot Project in five districts viz., Thiruvannamalai, Veilore, Cuddalore, Tiruvallur, Villupuram at a total cost of Rs.118.929 lakhs.

5) The Project Director, RMSA, has therefore requested to sanction the fund of Rs.118.929 lakhs (Rupees one crore eighteen lakhs ninety two thousand and nine hundred only) for Tamil Nadu Excels to conduct coaching classes for students in Secondary and Higher Secondary level as a pilot in 5 districts viz. Thiruvannamalai, Vellore, Cuddalore, Tiruvallur, Vilupuram under the scheme of Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) under State Innovation Fund for the year 2015-16.

6) The Government agreed to the proposal of the Project Director, Rashtriya Madhyamik Shiksha Abhiyan (RMSA), at para 5 above, and accordingly sanction a sum of Rs.118.92 lakhs (Rupees one crore eighteen lakhs and ninety two thousand only) towards Tamil Nadu Excels programme under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) for the year 2015-16 for the above scheme, as approved by the State Planning Commission.

7) The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited to the following head of account :-

“2202 General Education - 02 Secondary Education - 109 Government Secondary Schools - schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan -II State Plan - KN Tamil Nadu Excels (TANEX) Scheme under State Innovation Fund - 72 Training”.


