ORDER:-

The State Planning Commission has approved the proposal of the Director General of Police, Chennai for installation of Facial Recognition System for Secretariat at a cost of Rs.85.25 lakhs under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) Schemes for the year 2017-2018 (Round-II).

- 2. This project aims to identify and capture the anti social elements and unauthorised entry inside Secretariat Campus, Chennai by installing cameras at the entry levels which could be monitored at a control room. Further, at the control room with the help of the facial recognition software and employee database, it would be possible to distinguish the visitors.
- 3. The Director General of Police has informed that Government have provided funds for a sum of Rs.85,25,000/- for the Scheme "Installation of Facial Recognition System for Secretariat" under the following head of Account in first Supplementary Estimates 2017-18 dated 12.01.2018 and as well as in Revised Estimates 2017-2018.

- 4. The Director General of Police has therefore requested to accord necessary administrative sanction to the tune of Rs.85,25,000/- (Rupees eighty five lakhs and twenty five thusand only) to implement the above said scheme.
- 5. The Government accordingly accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.85.25 lakhs (Rupees Eighty Five Lakhs and Twenty Five Thousand only) for the implementation of "Installation of Facial Recognition System for Secretariat" under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) Schemes for the year 2017-2018 (Round-II) subject to condition that;
 - (i) The expenditure has to be incurred only for the purpose sanctioned by the State Planning Commission.
 - (ii) Upspent/Savings amount, if any, has to be surrendered to Government account.
- 6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be met from the provision made in First Supplementary Estimates 2017-18 and as well in Revised Estimates 2017-2018 under the following head of account:-

"2055 - 00 - Police - 001 Direction and Administration State's Expenditure - JB Installation of Facial Recognition system for Secretariat - Under State Innovation Fund -19 Machinery and Equipments - 01 purchase (DPC 2055 00 001 JB 19 18)"

7. The expenditure so incurred shall be adjusted by deducting under the following head of account. The actual expenditure incurred may be intimated to Finance (Home-I) /BG-II) Department at an appropriate time "2055-00-Police 902 – Deduct – Amount met from State Innovation Fund State's Expenditure
