5. After careful examination, the Government accorded Administrative Sanction for a sum of Rs.4,00,000/- (Rupees four lakhs only) towards implementation of the scheme of "Study on Effect of Nano clay in Bituminous Mixes" under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives for the year 2018 – 2019 as detailed in para 4 above with a condition that the findings of study and implementation report to be submitted to State Planning Commission by the Director, Highways Research Station, Highways Department.
