ORDER

The Standing Finance Committee has approved the proposal of the Director (i/c), Forensic Sciences Department, Chennai, for creation of a dedicated “Counterfeit Indian Currency Profiling Unit” in the Physics Division of the Main Forensic Science Laboratory, Chennai, for creating and maintaining a data base relating to various types of counterfeit notes seized by Police Department for analysis, at a total outlay of

Rs.85,11,000/- (Rupees eighty five lakh and eleven thousand only) for a period of one year under the Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives Schemes, as detailed below:-

In the Government order eighth read above, necessary funds have been provided in the Final Modified Appropriation for the year 2018-2019.

2. Accordingly, the Government accord administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.85,11,000/- (Rupees eighty five lakh and eleven thousand only) for the year 2018-2019 for establishment of a dedicated "Counterfeit Indian Currency Profiling Unit" (CICPU) with adequate infrastructure, such as (i) Optical comparison systems for forensic science application with work station and software for recording, storing and retrieving the images of the Fake Indian Currency Notes and (ii) a software for image mapping in the Physics Division of the Main Forensic Science Laboratory, Chennai, under the Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives for the year 2018-2019, as detailed below:-


