In the reference first read above, the State Planning Commission has, among others recommended for Monitoring the asphyxia babies in SNCUs by Provision of Amplitude integrated Electroencephalography (AiEEG) to 3 Sick Neonatal Care Units (SNCU) at Institute of Obstetrics and Gynecology and Government Hospital for Women and Children, Institute of Child Health and Hospital for Children and Government Chengalpet Medical College and Hospital, Chengalpet under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) funds.

Based on the above recommendation, the Mission Director, National Health Mission has forwarded the proposals and request to the Government for Establish the Monitoring the asphyxia babies in SNCUs by Provision of Amplitude integrated Electroencephalography (AiEEG) to 3 Sick Neonatal Care Units (SNCU) at Institute of Obstetrics and Gynecology and Government Hospital for Women and Children, Institute of Child Health and Hospital for Children and Government Chengalpet Medical College and Hospital, Chengalpet under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) funds and sanction an amount of Rs.45.00 lakhs towards procurement and supply of Amplitude integrated Electroencephalography (AiEEG) equipment to 3 Sick Neonatal Care Units (SNCU) at Institute of Obstetrics and Gynecology and Government Hospital for Women and Children, Institute of Child Health and Hospital for Children and Government Chengalpet Medical College and Hospital, Chengalpet through Tamil Nadu Medical Service Corporation Limited.

The Government have examined the proposal in detailed and permit the Mission Director, National Health Mission to establish the Monitoring of asphyxia babies in SNCUs by provision of Amplitude integrated Electroencephalography (EEG) to 3 Sick Neonatal Care Units (SNCU) at Institute of Obstetrics and Gynecology and Government Hospital for Women and Children, Institute of Child Health and Hospital for Children and Government Chengalpet Medical College and Hospital, Chengalpet through Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) funds from the State Planning Commission and sanction an amount of Rs.45.00 lakhs (Rupees Forty five lakh only) towards procurement and supply of Amplitude integrated Electroencephalography (AiEEG) equipment to 3 Sick Neonatal Care Units (SNCU) at Institute of Obstetrics and Gynecology and Government Hospital for Women and Children, Institute of Child Health and Hospital for Children and Government Chengalpet Medical College and Hospital, Chengalpet through Tamil Nadu Medical Service Corporation Limited as detailed below:
