### ORDER:

In the announcement made by the former Hon'ble Chief Minister on 23.09.2016, it was stated that Free Internet facility will be provided in 50 Government Schools and Free WiFi facility will be provided in 50 Public places like Bus Stands and Parks .

2. In the letter 1<sup>st</sup> read above, the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Arasu Cable TV Corporation Limited has requested for sanction of Rs.2009 lakhs from State Innovation Fund for Tamil Nadu Public WiFi Services Project to establish WiFi zones in public places to enable common man to access G2C services under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) Schemes 2017-2018.

3. In the letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Member Secretary, State Planning Commission (SPC) has informed that the proposal has been approved by the State Planning Commission for funding under TANII Schemes for the year 2017-2018 with a reduced outlay of Rs.850.00 lakhs.

4. The Government, after careful examination, sanction a sum of Rs.8,50,00,000/- (Rupees eight crore and fifty lakh only) from State Innovation Fund towards Tamil Nadu Free Public WiFi Services Development under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) Schemes 2017-2018.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:

- 4221.Capital Outlay on Broadcasting-80. General-190. Investments in Public Sector and Other Undertakings-State's Expenditure - JA. Provision of Wi-Fi in Public Places – Scheme under State Innovation Fund. - 22.Investments (D.P.Code.4221-80-190-JA-2203)

The above expenditure shall be adjusted by deducting under the following head of account.

4221.Capital Outlay on Broadcasting-80.General-902. Deduct – Amount met from Reserve Fund/Deposit Account – State's Expenditure – JA.Deduct – Amount met from State Innovation Fund – 30.Inter-Account Transfers. (D.P.Code.4221-80-902-JA-3005)

6. The Section Officer (Bills), Information Technology Department is authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in paragraph 4 above to the PD account of Tamil Nadu Arasu Cable TV Corporation Limited.

The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Arasu Cable TV Corporation Limited is authorized to take appropriate measures as necessary for the successful implementation of the project in consultation with the Board. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Arasu Cable TV Corporation Limited is also directed to send the physical and financial progress report of project every month to the Principal Secretary to Government, Information Technology Department along with the details of expenditure and Utilisation Certificate.
