ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Principal Secretary/ Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has stated that an Announcement has been made in the Assembly during 2017-2018 on the Sleep improvement project as study on the Economic Effects of Improving Sleep among the Urban poor in Tamil Nadu by J-PAL in co-ordination with the Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board and Housing and Urban Development Department at the total outlay of Rs.2.58 crore. The research study is under strengthening evidence based policy making and enhance well being of the Urban Poor.

2. In the letter second read above, the Member Secretary, State Planning Commission has stated that the proposal of Research Study of Economic effects of improving sleep among the Urban Poor in Tamil Nadu was recommended by the State Planning Commission for the year 2017-2018 for a sum of Rs.2.58 crore and he has enclosed a copy of the minutes and recommendations in this regard. Further, it has been informed by the State Planning Commission that this study project has been approved in the Fourth Steering Committee meeting held on 28.03.2017 and the identified saving of Rs.17.82 lakh in the scheme namely Promoting Latrine use in Rural Tamil Nadu needs to be utilized for this project as per Government Letter No.6002/ST-2&E/2016 Planning Development and Special Initiatives Department, dated 13.07.2017.

In the letter third read above, Principal Secretary / Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has also stated that as per announcement made in the Assembly during 2017-2018, on the sleep improvement project as study on - The Economic Effects of Improving sleep among the Urban Poor in Tamil Nadu by J-PAL in co-ordination with Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board and Housing and Urban Development Department at the total outlay of Rs.2.58 crore was recommended by the State Planning Commission during the meeting held on 05.10.2017 and 06.10.2017. He has requested the Government to sanction the sum of Rs.2.58 crore towards implementation of the scheme of Research Study on "the Economic Effects of Improving Sleep among the Urban Poor" in Tamil Nadu by J-PAL and Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) for the year 2017-2018.

4. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Principal Secretary/ Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board at para 3 above and accord sanction for a sum of Rs.2,58,08,000/- (Rupees two crore fifty eight lakh and eight thousand only) towards implementation of the scheme of Research Study on "the Economic Effects of Improving Sleep among the Urban Poor" in Tamil Nadu by J-PAL in co-ordination with Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board under Tamil Nadu Innovation initiatives (TANII) for the year 2017-2018 (Round II).

5. The Expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 4 above shall be debited into the following Head of Account:
