ORDER:-

In the letter first read above, The Member Secretary, State Planning Commission has conveyed his recommendation for 'Installation of Design and Development of Industrial Combined Washing and Hydro-extractor for Silk Materials' for one society at a cost of Rs.5.00 lakh in the sharing pattern of 60:40 between the State Government and the Society.

2. The Director of Handlooms and Textiles in the letter second read above has requested among other things to sanction a sum of Rs.3,00,000/- as State Government share towards 'Installation of Design and Development of Industrial Combined Washing and Hydro-extractor for Silk Materials' in Kancheepuram under the Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives Scheme for the year 2017-18.

3. The Government, after careful consideration of the proposal of the Director of Handlooms and Textiles accord sanction for a sum of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three lakh only) for 'Installation of Design and Development of Industrial Combined Washing and Hydro-extractor for Silk Materials' in Kancheepuram under the Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives Scheme for the year 2017-18.

4. The amount sanctioned in para 3 above shall be met from the State Innovation fund and debited to the following head of account:-
